Die XML-basierte metalexikographische Analyse des makro- und mikrostrukturellen Aufbaus legt dabei den Zweck des Wörterbuches offen und durch sozial- und bildungshistorische Studien wird herausgearbeitet, wie, von wem und wozu die Handschriften tatsächlich genutzt wurden und was die zeitgenössischen NutzerInnen kritisierten.
